INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING 24-HOUR REPORTS OF EXPENDITURES

For Special Election for SD 7

What expenditures should be reported?

Political action committees and State Party Committees must disclose any expenditure of \$500 or more made during the last thirteen (13) days before the election. Local Party Committees must disclose any expenditure of \$1,000 or more made during the last thirteen (13) days before the election. Report only those expenditures that pertain to the Special Election in Senate District 7. The dates are:

Special Election: April 26 – May 9, 2011

When this report must be filed?

The report must be filed by fax or in person within 24 hours of the expenditure. After 5:00 pm or on Saturdays and Sundays they must be faxed in. The fax number is 287-6775.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

The information contained in this report must also be included on the appropriate schedule of the next regularly scheduled campaign finance report.

Effective April 11, 2007, if an expenditure is disclosed in an independent expenditure report, it is no longer necessary to file a separate 24-hour report for the same expenditure.
