Area - 13 acres

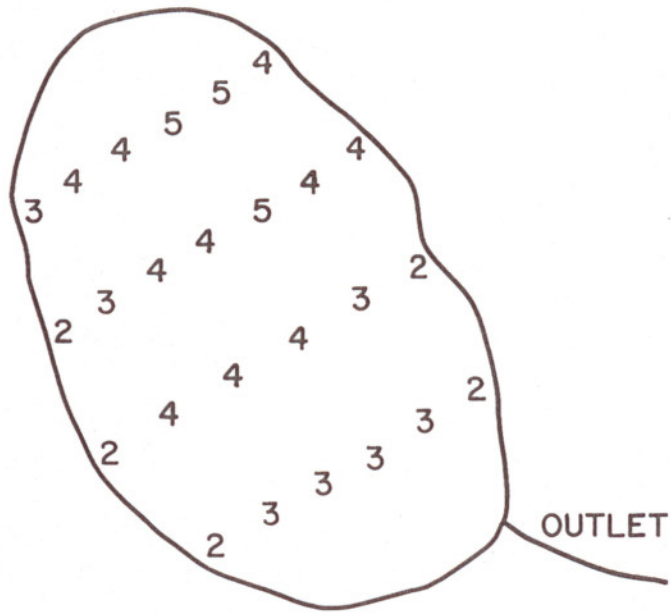
Temperatures

Maximum depth - 5 feet

Luciffee Pond is shallow and becomes warm at all depths during hot weather. Trout must seek limited spring areas at this time to survive.

The outlet is very small, clogged with old beaver dams, and is of little value as trout spawning and nursery area. Since the pond has no tributaries, and springs and gravelly shoals are limited, trout spawning facilities are considered poor.

If future fishing pressure in the area increases sufficiently, trout stocking to supplement natural reproduction may be justified.
