

## CAPISIC POND Portland Twp., Cumberland Co. U.S.G.S. Portland, Me. (7.5')

Minnows Goldfish Hornpout (bullhead) American eel

**Physical Characteristics** 

Area - 4 acres

Maximum depth - 4 feet

Temperature: Surface - 77°F 4 feet - 77°F

Principal fisheries: none

This is a small, shallow pond located in a suburban area just outside of downtown Portland. The pond exhibits thick cattail growth during the summer months and the characteristics of the pond limit its fishery potential to hornpout.

This pond has been plagued for years with sewage inputs from excess storm water discharges. A task force was setup in the mid 1990's to look into cleaning up the Capisic watershed.

Access can be obtained via the road shoulder of Capisic Street.
