Suggested Management

Little Pond is a warm, shallow pond. Large populations of sunfish, chain pickerel, and golden shiners were observed. There are no adequate tributaries and the outlet is presently blocked by a large beaver dam.

The size and general characteristics of this pond preclude stocking of either warm-water or cold-water fishes. Little Pond should be managed for the pickerel fishery.
