Torry Pond is a rich, shallow pond well suited for warmwater fish. No game fish of any type were observed during the original survey of the pond. An experimental stocking of largemouth bass was recommended to provide a fishery. The bass were introduced in 1958 and 1959, and have become well established.

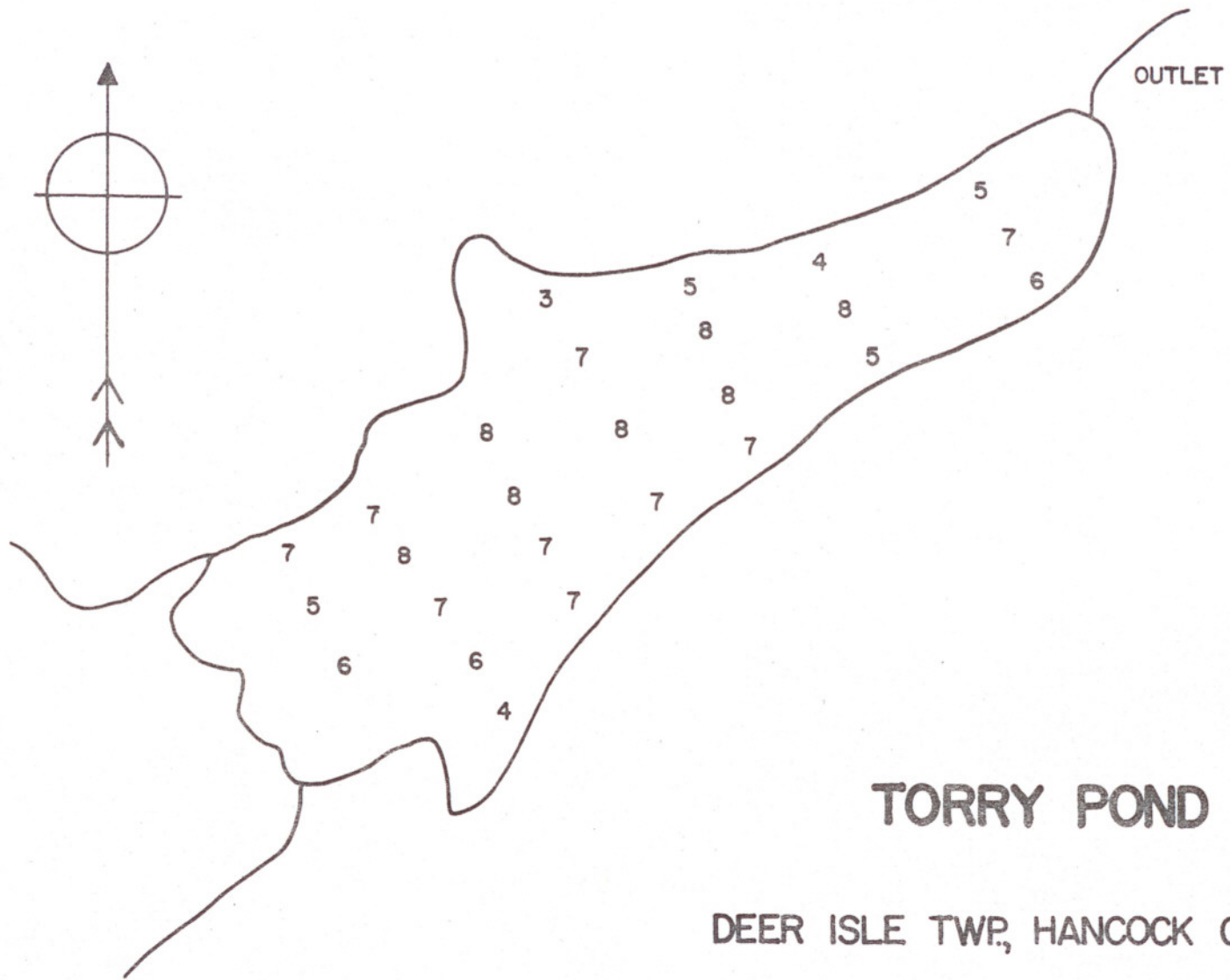
Management should emphasize this species.

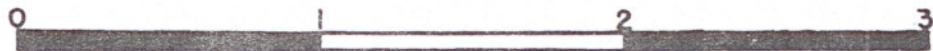
