Principal fisheries: White perch, chain pickerel, yellow perch

Anderson Pond is a small isolated pond with marginal water quality for brook trout and a large number of competing warm water species. If the pond could be chemically reclaimed a brook trout stocking program would be initiated. Unfortunately, there is no public access to Anderson Pond. Reclamation will not be considered until public access is obtained.
