Mansfield Pond provides good habitat for warmwater fish species. Brook trout are caught occasionally in the pond. These trout originated from either the small native population in the tributaries or are stocked trout having migrated from Alford Pond.

Access to Mansfield Pond is limited to canoe or small hand-carried boat.
