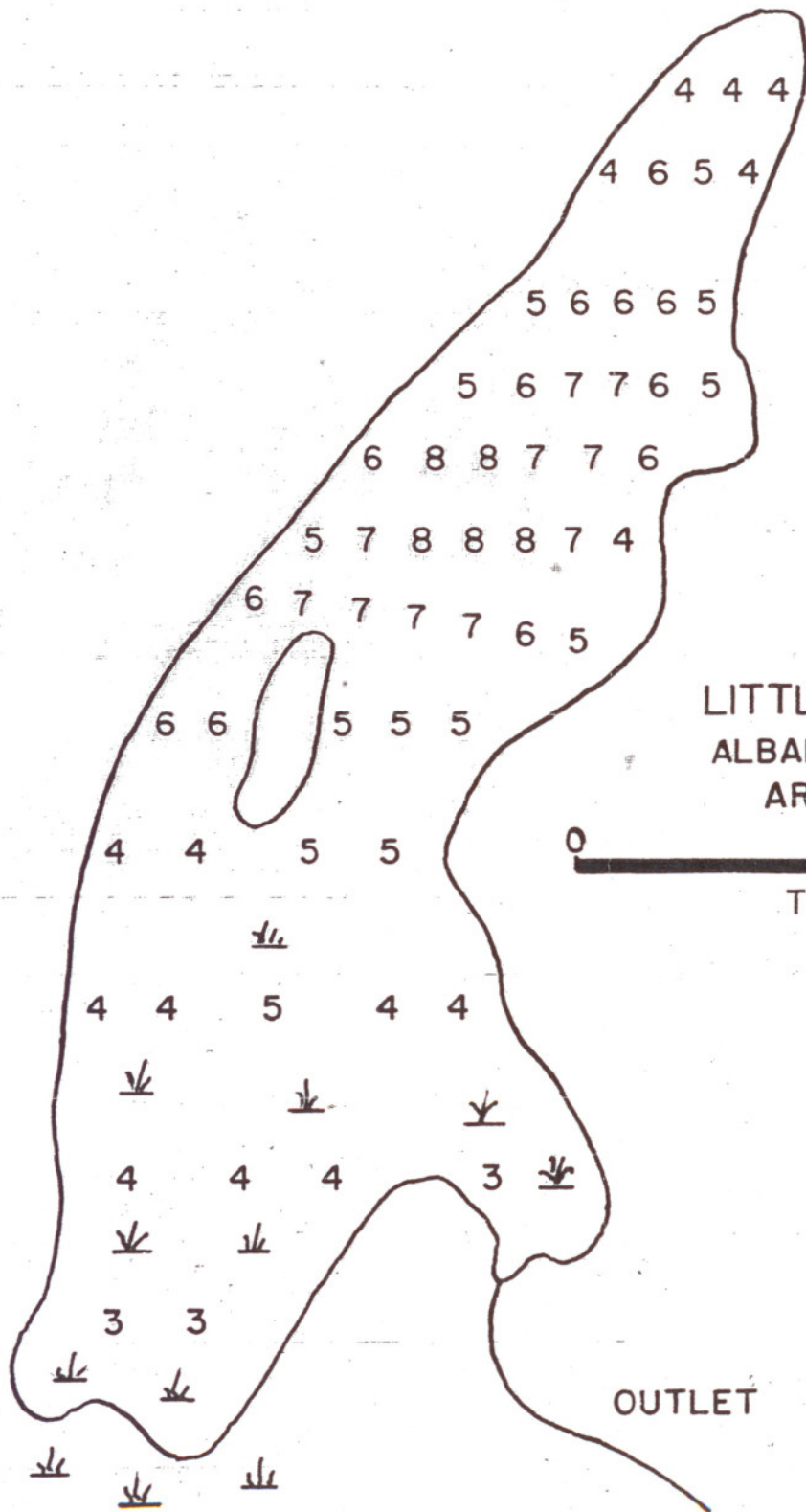

Little Papoose Pond is a shallow weedy pond, which is best suited for warmwater fisheries management. In 1992, the Maine Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife stocked largemouth bass, which are now supporting a self-sustaining fishery.

Access is restricted to permissive trespass along a dirt road off Routes 5 and 35.
