


Lost Pond is located south of Spencer Lake. An inlet enters the northwest corner of the pond and its outlet flows southeast into Little Spencer Stream. The pond's shoreline is undeveloped.

Water quality in Lost Pond is poor for coldwater gamefish. Water temperatures in this very shallow pond reach critically high levels in the warm summer months. The pond lacks any suitable spawning or nursery habitat for salmonids. The pond is not stocked.

Lost Pond is accessible via a series of private gated roads east of Route 27. The pond is open to fishing under general law in the summer and closed to ice fishing.
