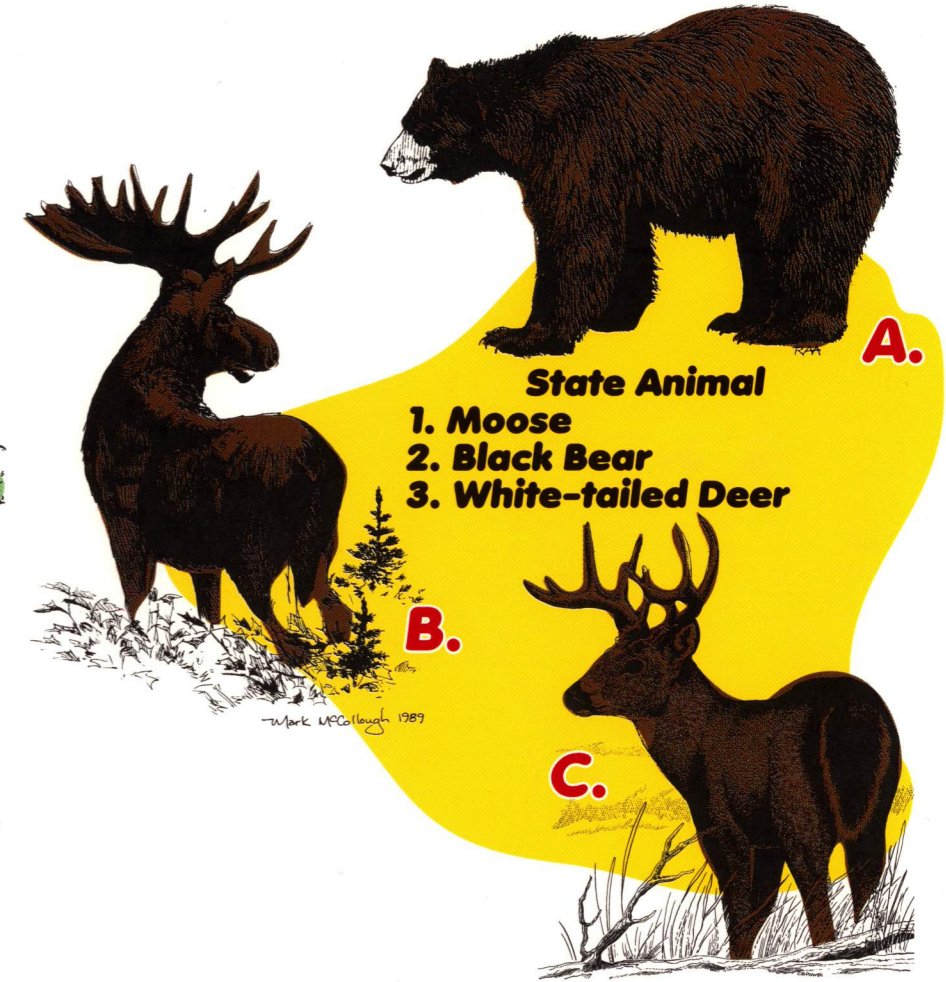
**State Cat**
