Principal Fishery: Chain pickerel

Moody Pond contains only a small volume of water capable of supporting fish life during much of the year. Nearly two-thirds of the pond is deficient in dissolved oxygen thereby limiting fish habitat to the warm water littoral areas.

There is a limited sport fishery for pickerel in Moody Pond, with only a small number of small fish available to the angler.

An unimproved road leads off State Route 17 to the western shore of Moody Pond.


