Whittier is a small shallow pond that maintains natural populations of both smallmouth and largemouth bass. Anglers can expect to catch many 10-12 inch bass with the opportunity to catch the occasional 3-4 pound bass.

There is potential to improve habitat for coldwater fish species by chemical reclamation of Whittier Pond but is not feasible at this time. There are two major obstacles to overcome before reclamation would be considered. A deeded public right-of-way would have to be secured and a barrier dam would need to be constructed on the outlet to prevent migration of undesirable species.


Because there is no public access to Whittier Pond, anglers must cross over private land. To date, no problems have been reported, but anglers should ask permission and respect landowners rights prior to entering their land.
