Musquash Pond is a shallow warm, weedy pond ideally suited for warmwater fishes. Tributaries are characterized by marshy, weedy habitat. Ledge outcrops are scattered along the shoreline.

An unimproved launch site is located off the Weeks road on the west side of the pond.


