
Suggested Management

Green Pond provides suitable habitat for brook trout. Local sportsmen and sportsmen's groups should consider reclamation to develop the full potential of the pond. Prerequisites to reclamation include:

1. Construction of a barrier dam on the outlet to prevent the re-establishment of undesirable fishes.
2. Establishment of a public right-of-way to allow access to the pond.
3. Enactment of the following protective regulations:
 - a. No live fish for bait
 - b. No ice fishing
 - c. Five trout limit


