Suggested Management

During the summer months the water temperatures of B Pond are nearly equal at all depths. Water quality conditions are considered very good for brook trout.

The two principal inlets have extensive areas of excellent spawning and nursery habitat which will easily maintain a good population of brook trout. Care must be taken to keep these tributaries unobstructed by beaver dams.

Net collections indicated that a large population of brook trout is present. B Pond should be managed exclusively for brook trout.

Only three other fishes are competing with the brook trout. The regulation prohibiting the use or possession of live fish as bait should be adopted to prevent the introduction of additional species.
