Suggested Management



Burden is a shallow and very productive pond. A good brook trout population is present, though there is much competition from the large populations of suckers, minnows, and sunfish.

The pond is not accessible by road and the fishing pressure is light.

Burden Pond should be managed for brook trout. The facilities for natural reproduction are adequate.
