

Crescent Pond contains a large volume of cold, deep, well-oxygenated water throughout the summer months. The pond has excellent habitat for coldwater fishes, with superior spawning and nursery areas along the shores. The southwest tributary is spring-fed and also provides excellent spawning and nursery areas for brook trout.


Crescent Pond should be managed for brook trout and togue. There is also a whitefish population which serves as a forage fish for the togue.
