Suggested Management

Upper Togue is shallower than Lower Togue and is marginal in dissolved oxygen for salmonids below 25 feet. Unfortunately, a pickerel population is established in both Upper and Lower Togue Ponds.

Management for salmonids would entail reclamation by chemical means, an undertaking not economically justified with present methods.
