Baker Pond located north of Moxie Lake is a shallow pond with a muddy bottom. It has no major inlets. Its outlet flows from the southern tip of the pond through a cedar swamp into Moxie Stream. The shoreline is wooded and undeveloped.


Baker Pond is too shallow to support coldwater gamefish. Water temperatures reach critical levels for salmonids in the summer months.

Access to Baker Pond is via a short foot trail reached from the Harris Dam Road.
