Brook trout (squaretail)

White sucker

Area - 12 acres

Temperatures

Maximum depth - 36 feet

Surface - 70° F.

35 feet - 67° F.

Suggested Management


Horseshoe Pond should be managed for brook trout. Annual stocking will be required to support the fishery.

Regulations should be established closing the pond to ice fishing and prohibiting the use or possession of live fish as bait.

Ideally the pond should be reclaimed to eliminate the sucker population. Public access to the pond must be guaranteed before reclamation can be considered.
