Notice to Contractors

Dolby Landfill Closure and Capping Upgrade -Phase 1

The State of Maine is seeking proposals to construct an upgrade of the cover system for the state-owned Dolby III/II Landfill in East Millinocket in an effort to improve the performance of the existing cover system for the in place waste (Predominantly pulp and paper wastes from operations of the former Great Northern Paper Company mills in Millinocket and East Millinocket.) and significantly reduce the volume of leachate generated at the landfill in order to minimize future costs associated with transporting and treating leachate. Approximately 72 acres of the Dolby III area and 25 acres of Dolby II area will be re-covered over a 4-5 year construction period. Portions of the existing cover system on Dolby III/II will be re-used in the construction upgrade. Phase 1 of the project is anticipated to commence in 2016 and will consist of approximately 25 acres on Dolby III, cells 15,16,17. Phases 2 and 3 of the cover upgrade will consist of the remainder of Dolby III, including portions of an access road separating Dolby III and II. Phase 4 will consist of an upgrade to portions of Dolby II that are upgradient of Dolby III.

The cost of the work is approximately \$ 3,200,000. The work to be performed under this contract shall be completed on or before *31 October 2016*.

2. The bid shall be submitted on the Contractor Bid Form (section 00 41 13) provided in the Bid Documents. The Owner reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids as may best serve the interest of the Owner.
3. Bid security *is required* on this project.
The Bidder shall include a satisfactory Bid Bond (section 00 43 13) or a certified or cashier's check for 5% of the bid amount with the completed bid form submitted to the Owner.
4. Performance and Payment Bonds *are required* on this project.
The selected Contractor shall furnish a 100% contract Performance Bond (section 00 61 13.13) and a 100% contract Payment Bond (section 00 61 13.16) in the contract amount to cover the execution of the Work.
5. Filed Sub-bids *are not required* on this project.
6. There *are no* Pre-qualified General Contractors on this project.

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7. An on-site pre-bid conference *will* be conducted for this project.
The pre-bid conference is *mandatory* for General Contractors and optional for Subcontractors and suppliers. Contractors who arrive late or leave the meeting early may be prohibited from participating in this meeting and bidding. *The Pre-bid conference will be held at the offices of Mid-South Engineering, 70 Spring Street, Millinocket, ME 04462 on April 20, 2016 at 1:00 PM EDT*
