NOTICE OF DENIAL

Dear Mr. Ayers:

In a letter dated August 24, 2015, you received notice that the Maine State Board of Nursing was denying licensure for the following reasons:

32 M.R.S. §2105-A (2)(B) Misuse of alcohol, drugs, or other substances that has resulted or may result in the licensee performing services in a manner that endangers the health or safety of patient.s

32 M.R.S. §2105-A (2)(F) Unprofessional conduct. A licensee is considered to engaged in unprofessional conduct if the licensee violates a standard of professional behavior that has been established in the practice for which the licensee is licensed.

This office did not receive a written notice of appeal within thirty (30) days as specified in the Notice of Preliminary Denial. Therefore, the preliminary denial is now final and constitutes final agency action.
