INTRODUCTION

This document is a Consent Agreement regarding Kevin McMorrow's license to practice professional nursing in the State of Maine. The parties enter into this Agreement pursuant to 10 M.R.S.A. § 8003(5)(B) and 32 M.R.S.A. § 2105-A(1-A). The parties to this Consent Agreement are Kevin McMorrow, Maine State Board of Nursing ("Board") and the Department of Attorney General, State of Maine. The parties reached this Agreement as result of information submitted by MaineGeneral Medical Center by letter dated July 16, 1999.

FACTS

- 1. Kevin McMorrow, R.N., license number R027792, was suspended without pay pending investigation of suspected drug diversion from the operating room. Subsequent to this suspension Mr. McMorrow has admitted to diverting Fentanyl and has voluntarily entered a drug rehabilitation program.
- 2. On July 7, 1999 Mr. McMorrow voluntarily surrendered his nursing license to the Maine State Board of Nursing.

AGREEMENT

- 3. The Maine State Board of Nursing will accept Kevin McMorrow's voluntary surrender of his license, license number R027792.
- 4. Kevin McMorrow shall not work, in any capacity, in the health care field, including in a veterinarian's office, while his nursing license is surrendered. In addition, Mr. McMorrow is not to seek employment where the handling or dispensing of drugs is part of the job responsibility.
- 5. Kevin McMorrow may petition the Board for reinstatement of his license. Mr. McMorrow agrees and understands that his license will not be reinstated until and unless the Board, upon Mr. McMorrow's written request, votes to reinstate Mr. McMorrow's license.



- 6. Kevin McMorrow understands that this document imposes discipline regarding his license to practice professional nursing in the State of Maine. Mr. McMorrow understands that he does not have to execute this Consent Agreement and that he has the right to consult with an attorney before entering the Consent Agreement.
- 7. Modification of this Consent Agreement must be in writing and signed by all parties.
- 8. Kevin McMorrow affirms that he executes this Consent Agreement of his own free will.
- 9. This Consent Agreement is not subject to review or appeal by the Licensee, but may be enforced by an action in the Superior Court.
- 10. This Consent Agreement becomes effective upon the date of the last necessary signature below.
