RE: 7th round ConnectME grant pre-application process – Robbinston, Maine

Dear Phil:

FairPoint is considering applying for a ConnectME grant to deploy broadband in Robbinston, Maine. We would deploy broadband to unserved areas where FairPoint does not already provide broadband service. The proposed project would cover 436 working lines and any dwellings that might be within those working lines. The total cost of this build-out is approximately \$73,700. Should we move forward with the grant application, we would be requesting a 50 percent grant.

As far as we can determine, this area does not have landline, cable, or much fixed wireless broadband service. The Robbinston First Selectmen has also indicated that the town does not have wide access to broadband service.

FairPoint would propose to provide digital subscriber line (DSL) broadband service at speeds ranging from 3MG to 7MG, depending upon loop length and the specific service ordered by customers. FairPoint would complete installation of this service within 12 months after receiving grant approval.
