On September 6, the MCA Board approved the hiring of Doug Bourget as the MCA School Leader.

Doug Bourget received a Bachelor of Arts from Marlboro College, a Master of Arts in Teaching from the University of Southern California, and is nearly done with his Certificate of Advanced Study in Educational Leadership from the University of Southern Maine. He also has three years of public teaching experience in Busan, South Korea, including public school volunteer work in special education as well as Saturday art, math, and science courses. After returning from Korea, he joined Maine Connections Academy as an English teacher in 2014, where he has served as a lead 7-12 teacher as well as the truancy, student support, and RTI coordinator. Starting in August 2016, he has served as the Interim Principal of Maine Connections Academy. He has taught students in grades 1-12 and currently holds full Maine certification as a 7-12 English teacher and as a K-12 building administrator.
