*Pursuant to Title 7, Chapter 2-B. Because this farmland was registered on or after July 1, 2012, the law requires a future 50' setback between the edge of the registered farmland and any new incompatible use defined as a well, drinking water spring or water supply intake point on the abutting land.

You have the right to challenge the eligibility of this farmland by initiating an appeal process at the municipal office within 15 days of your receipt of this notice.

In the future, if you have reason to doubt the continued eligibility of this farmland, you may initiate an appeal once every two years. You may also seek a variance from the setback requirement from the municipality. The municipality may grant a variance if the abutting lot would be rendered unusable by compliance with required setback. As described on the FARMLAND REGISTRATION FACT SHEET (FORM 1) that was enclosed with my NOTICE OF INTENT TO REGISTER FARMLAND, some abutting lands are exempt.
