PUBLIC NOTICE

In accordance with 5 M.R.S.A Section 6200 et seq., the Land for Maine's Future Board announces that it will be voting on a proposal to allocate funds to support the Presumpscot Regional Land Trust acquisition of an agricultural conservation easement over 296.2± contiguous acres of agricultural and forested land. Access to the subject property is provided directly from Randall Road off of State Route 25. The subject property is comprised of 281.4 acres located in Standish, Cumberland County, State of Maine and is further described as the property of Richard C. Randall and identified on Town of Standish Tax Map 6, Lot 80 and Tax Map 10, Lots 89, 89A, 91, part of 92, and Lot 96A and, a 14.8± acre portion of the subject property is located in Gorham, Cumberland County, State of Maine and is further described as the property of Richard C. Randall and identified on Town of Gorham Tax Map 76, Lot 1 and Lot 14-2. The Presumpscot Regional Land Trust anticipates that this property will be used for agricultural land.

Public comment on this acquisition will be accepted at the Land for Maine's Future Board meeting on March 25, 2013. The meeting is scheduled to begin at 1p.m. at the ME Department of Agriculture, Conservation, and Forestry's Bolton Hill facility, 2870 North Belfast Ave, Augusta, Maine.
