In accordance with 5 M.R.S.A 6200 et seq., the Land for Maine's Future (LMF) Board will vote on a proposal to allocate funds for the Rangeley Lakes Heritage Trust's acquisition of 17+/- acres of land for public use. The land is located on the south side of US Route 16 (Wilson Mills Rd.) in Lincoln Plantation and along the Magalloway River. The Maine Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife will hold a Project Agreement on the land to ensure the intended use of the property. Public comment on this acquisition will be accepted at the LMF Board meeting to be held September 25, 2018, at 1:00 PM at the Marquardt Building, Room 118, located at 32 Blossom Lane, Augusta, ME.
