WHO MAY USE THIS FORM?

This form shall be used for the transfer of permit/certification authorization for the construction and/or operation of a hydropower project in the plantations, unorganized townships and certain towns which remain under the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission ("LURC" or "Commission") jurisdiction.
