What does this mean?

Areas zoned as General Development (D-GN) Subdistrict, Recreational Facility Development (D-RF) Subdistrict, or General Management (M-GN) Subdistrict, AND located within the Geographic Allowance Areas (illustrated in Purple) allow additional categories of Recreational Lodging Facilities.
