Fourteenth Procedural Order In the Matter of Site Law Certification SLC 9

Central Maine Power Company's New England Clean Energy Connect Project

July 17, 2019 Commissioner Everett Worcester, Chair and Presiding Officer

This Fourteenth Procedural Order ("Order") sets forth the Land Use Planning Commission ("Commission") Presiding Officer's decision with respect to a request to conduct a second site visit.

- 1. On June 27, 2019, the Commission conducted a site visit to view portions of the proposed New England Clean Energy Connect ("NECEC") project. A staff summary of the site visit was disseminated to the Commission and the Parties on July 9, 2019 ("Staff Memo").
- 2. The Staff Memo notes that the Commission was not able to gain access to the shoreline of Beattie Pond, as intended, due to access issues across private property.
- 3. On July 12, 2019, counsel for Intervenor Groups 2 and 10 requested that the Commission consider a rescheduled site visit to Beattie Pond.
- 4. The request to schedule a second site visit is denied.

This Procedural Order is issued by the Presiding Officer pursuant to Chapter 5. All objections to matters contained herein should be timely filed in writing with the Commission staff but are not to be further argued except by leave of the Presiding Officer. All rulings and objections will be noted in the record. The Presiding Officer may amend this Order at any time.
