Dear Mr. Murphy:

The Natural Resources Council of Maine wishes to withdraw its intervention in the Bull Hill Wind Project. As described at the pre-hearing conference and subsequently, NRCM needed time to more completely review the project, including through a site visit by our staff, which we have now had. While we have some concerns regarding this project, we believe NRCM's technical intervention in this project is not required.

Obviously NRCM's request to withdraw as an intervenor means waiving our privileges and responsibilities of intervention. We plan to deliver oral (and written) testimony at the evening session of the public hearing on May 16-17. While our comments at that session will be in the character of "Neither For Nor Against" the project, we believe we may have comments that will be valuable to the Commissioners. If possible, we request the opportunity to have 10-15 minutes to speak at that time.

Please communicate our request to the Commissioners and let me know if you have any questions. We appreciate your efforts to make this process clear and efficient so far.
