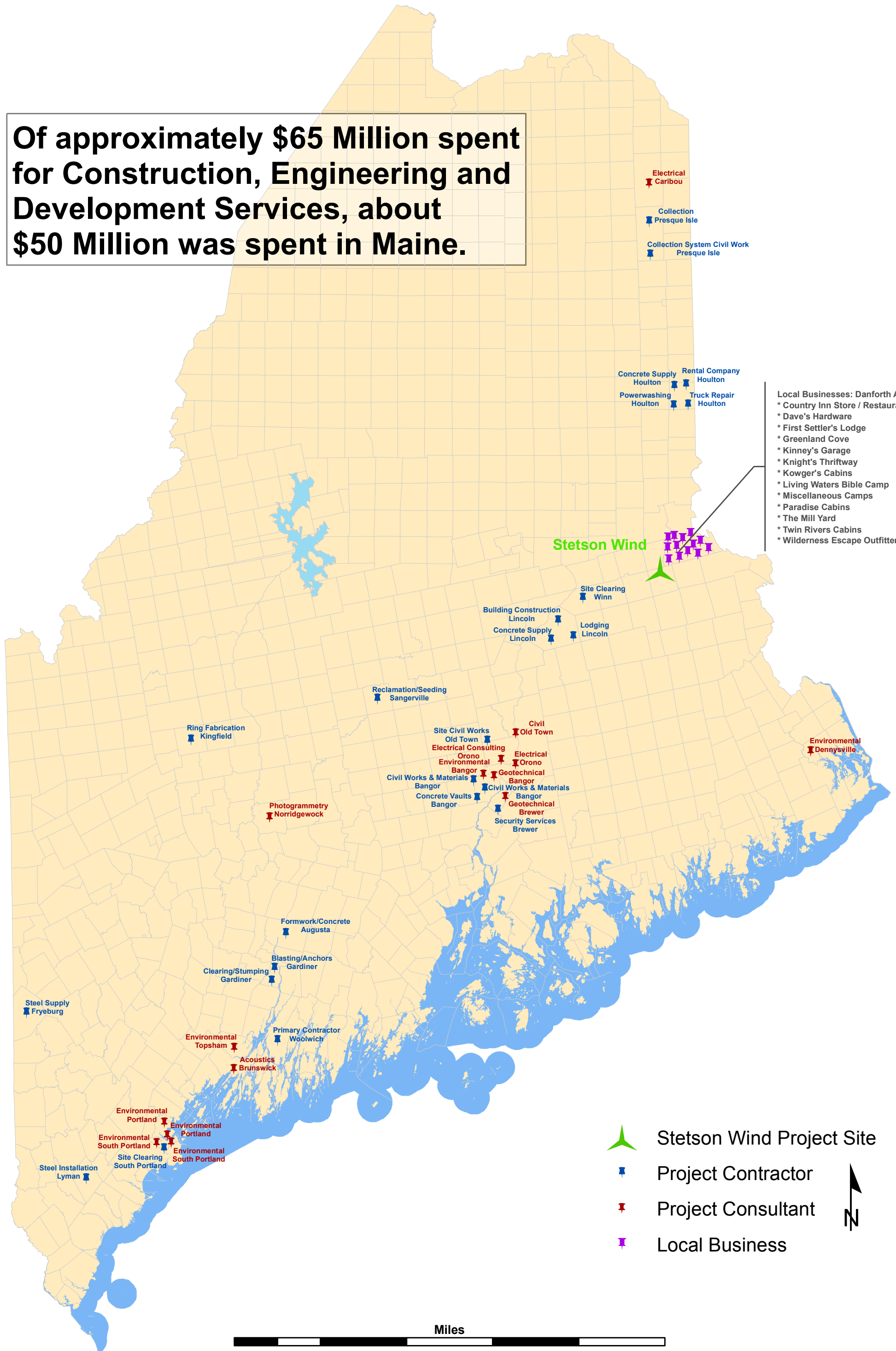

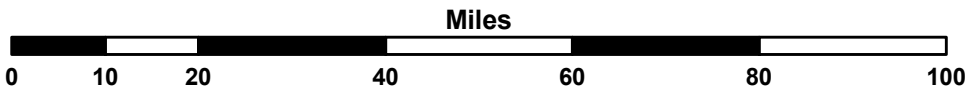
Maine Businesses Benefitting from Stetson Wind

Of approximately \$65 Million spent for Construction, Engineering and Development Services, about \$50 Million was spent in Maine.

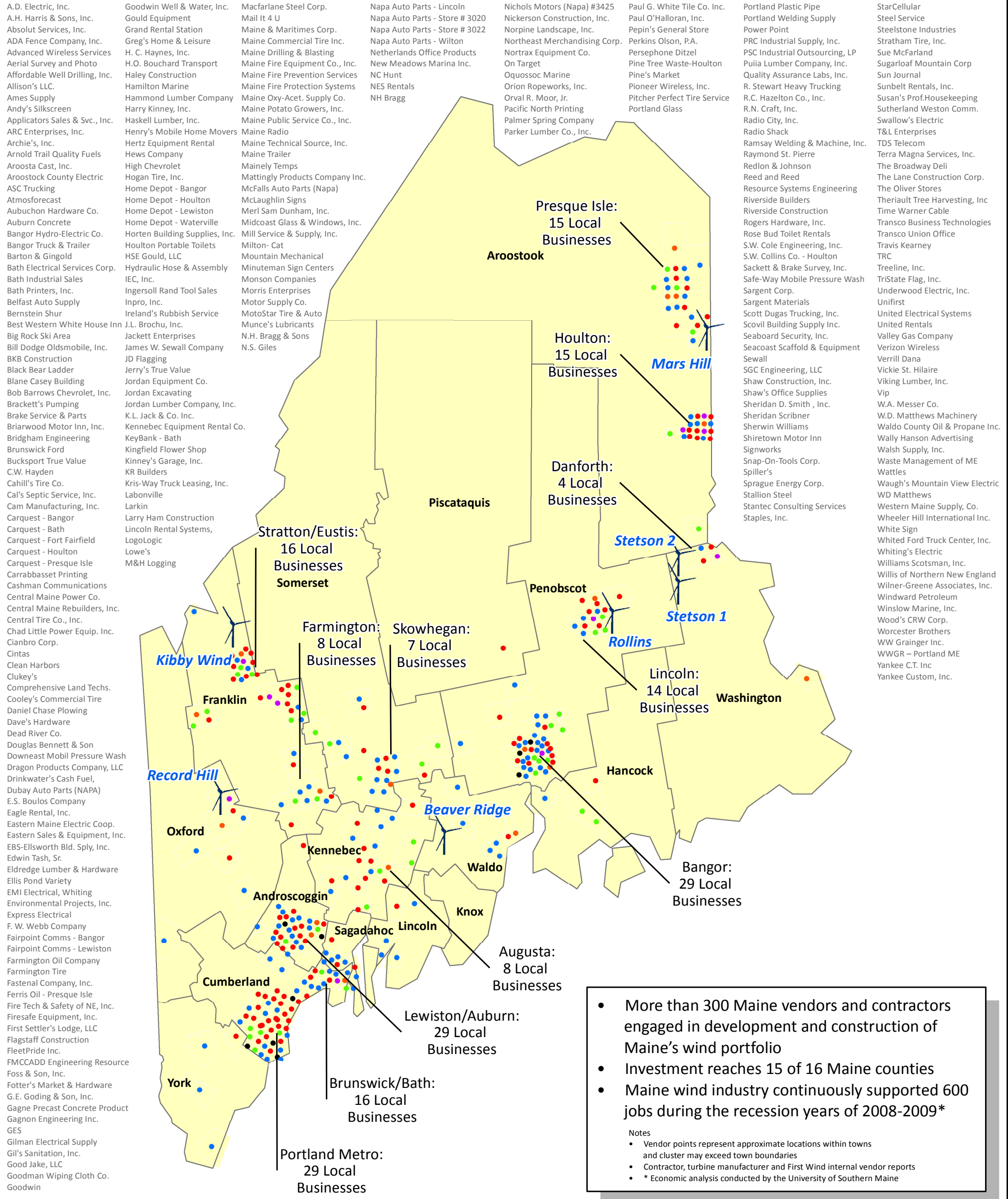
