
Enclosed please find a paper copy and CD of the Applicant's rebuttal testimony in the above matter. Due to the size of the exhibits, I am providing by e-mail a copy of the narrative portion only of the rebuttal testimony and am sending by overnight mail a CD of the complete testimony, including exhibits, to the intervenors.

Additionally, I am providing a fully executed copy of the Community Benefit Agreement with Carroll Plantation. This fully executed copy replaces Exhibit L to the Pre-Filed Direct Testimony of First Wind.

The Applicant requests 90 minutes for presentation of its testimony during the hearing. In light of the fact the Applicant bears the burden of proof on all issues, we believe 90 minutes is the minimum amount of time needed to fully and fairly present our case. We are cognizant of the need to be efficient and will be so. We are not requesting any time for cross-examination of the CLF witnesses, but would like to reserve 5 minutes for potential cross-examination of Mr. Mott. We are requesting 60 minutes for cross-examination of the PPDLW witnesses and at this time request that they all be available. We are also requesting 30 minutes for cross-examination of the witnesses presented by Mr. Corrigan, including in addition to Mr. Corrigan, David Tobey and Dale Tobey. Finally, at this time we are requesting that Dr. Palmer and IF&W be available on July 6<sup>th</sup> and are requesting 45 minutes of cross-examination. To the extent that other agency representatives are present and testify, we request 20 minutes for potential questioning of those additional witnesses.
