Subject: Maine Mountain Power permit application, Redington Township, Franklin County

Dear Interested Party;

On December 19, 2005 Maine Mountain Power (previously Redington Mountain Windpower) submitted its permit application on a CD to the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission (LURC) for a 30 turbine windfarm to be located in Redington Township, Franklin County. The application is now being assessed to determine if it is complete for processing. No timeline for accepting the LURC permit application as complete for processing has been established. If accepted for processing, agency and interested party review will begin at that time.

If accepted for processing, a notice that includes an outline of the processing procedure will be sent to you, along with a copy of the CD, if you request one. Alternatively, a paper copy will be made available for public viewing at LURC's Augusta office and LURC's Rangeley office. You may also be able to access a paper copy at the Franklin County Commissioner's office, the Town of Carrabassett Valley, or the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (MDEP) office in Augusta, but will need to contact those offices to verify.

Concurrently, the application was submitted to the MDEP, which is proceeding under its timeline for processing a Site Development Permit application. Further information on the MDEP permit application can be obtained from project manager Lisa-kay Keen. (207) 287-7875
