ZONING PETITION ZP 702, MAINE MOUNTAIN POWER, LLC REDINGTON TOWNSHIP, FRANKLIN COUNTY

Persons interested in seeking Intervenor status in the matter of Zoning Petition ZP 702, submitted to the Land Use Regulation Commission (LURC) by Maine Mountain Power, LLC for the proposed Redington Wind Farm in Redington Township, Franklin County, must file a **Petition to Intervene** to the Commission no later than 5:00 P.M. on Friday, May 19, 2006. **The Petition to Intervene** is pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Maine Administrative Procedures Act (5 M.R.S.A., Chapter 375) and Chapter 5 of the Commission's rules. The Commission will act on any such petitions at its regular business meeting on June 7, 2006. A pre-hearing conference for LURC staff, the applicant, and the Intervenors has been scheduled for June 8, 2006 in Augusta. The public hearing has been scheduled for the week of July 31, 2006 in the area of Carrabassett Valley, with the exact dates to be announced.
