

SECTION II: Forest Management Planning Menu and Current Reimbursement Rates

Forest Management Plans: Cost-share funds for Forest Management Planning will be allocated for the state as a whole, and applications will be accepted on a rolling basis. Applications will be approved on a first-come, first served basis in the Augusta MFS office, based on availability of funds.

Currently only applications for Woodland Resource Action Plans and Amendments of existing FMPs will be accepted. No other WoodsWISE forest management planning incentives are available until further notice.

The maximum cost-share payment to any single landowner in a calendar year will be \$2500.
