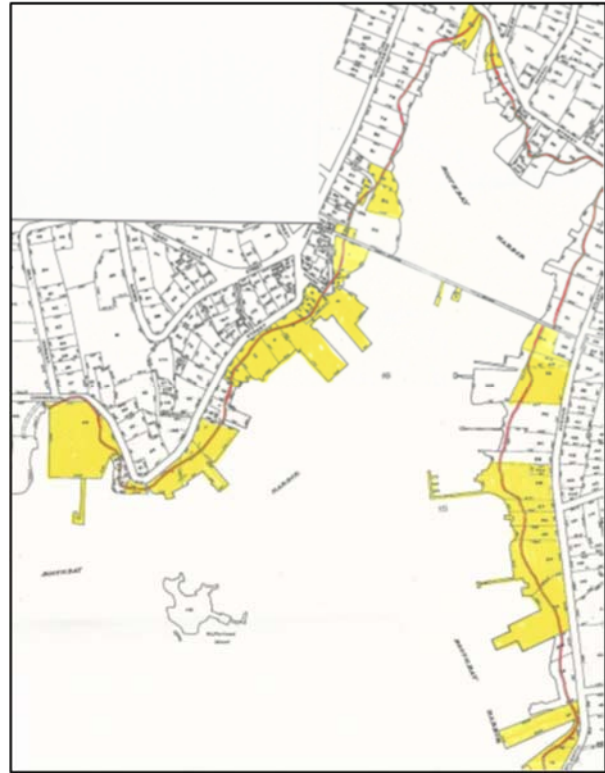




Lincoln County Regional Planning Commission Downtown Boothbay Harbor Adaptation Options for Increased Storm Surge Resiliency

PROJECT DESCRIPTION (projected completion December 2017)

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) finalized new Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMs) in 2015, which now clearly show buildings and structures in relation to the flood zone. The project will analyze flood risks for commercial and governmental structures in downtown Boothbay Harbor and provide recommendations for improving the flood resiliency of those structures and raise community awareness of the flood insurance program.
