PROJECT DESCRIPTION (Anticipated completion - March 2018)

The City of Bath is conducted a study to assess downtown stormwater runoff patterns and how they could be managed to mitigate the risk of flash-flooding and the volume of pollutants that are discharged into the Kennebec River. The study included an examination of management options and the development of conceptual designs for infrastructure improvements with a heavy emphasis on Low-Impact Design (LID).
