


## COASTAL COMMUNITY GRANTS: Water Quality & Land Use

## **PROJECT DESCRIPTION** (completed December 2018)

A build-out study of the York River watershed was prepared to provide information on the extent of development allowed under existing regulations and future scenarios and the potential impact on watershed resources under each scenario. The analysis was utilized to provide information to be used in developing resource protection strategies and guide changes to regulations for the long-term protection of resources as part of this project.
