PROJECT DESCRIPTION (Anticipated completion December 2021)

This project is an outgrowth of work by the Waldoboro Shellfish Committee's initiative which led to the formation of the Medomak Task Force to eliminate sources of fecal bacteria from entering the river and its Medomak River Watershed-Based Management Plan.

The goals of this project are two-fold; (1) to develop a formal guidance document which will provide coastal communities with a clear and effective roadmap for assessing and prioritizing septic system vulnerability; (2) to complete a thorough septic system vulnerability assessment for coastal parcels in the Town of Waldoboro to continue to improve water quality in the Medomak River and sustain the shellfish community.
