Speed equals distance traveled in time

- At 20 mph you are traveling 30 feet per second
- At 30 mph you are traveling 45 feet per second
- At 40 mph you are traveling 60 feet per second
- At 50 mph you are traveling 75 feet per second

Distance needed to slow down to 20 mph

- At 20 mph it takes 0 feet to slow down to 20 mph
- At 30 mph it takes 50 feet to slow down to 20 mph
- At 40 mph it takes 100 feet to slow down to 20 mph
- At 50 mph it takes 150 feet to slow down to 20 mph

Distance needed to stop

- At 20 mph it takes approximately 100 feet to stop
- At 30 mph it takes approximately 150 feet to stop
- At 40 mph it takes approximately 200 feet to stop
- At 50 mph it takes approximately 250 feet to stop
