As provided in the RFP, the Notice of Conditional Contract Award is subject to execution of a written contract and, as a result, this Notice does NOT constitute the formation of a contract between the Department and the apparent successful vendor. The vendor shall not acquire any legal or equitable rights relative to the contract services until a contract containing terms and conditions acceptable to the Department is executed. The Department further reserves the right to cancel this Notice of Conditional Contract Award at any time prior to the execution of a written contract.

As stated in the RFP, following announcement of this award decision, all submissions in response to the RFP are considered public records available for public inspection pursuant to the State of Maine Freedom of Access Act (FOAA). 1 M.R.S. §§ 401 et seq.; 5 M.R.S. § 1825-B (6).

Evaluation Team Comments:

Aspen Helicopters was the only bidder for this RFP.

The aircraft meets the requirements listed, and the Survey Program will work with Aspen Helicopters to ensure the life raft in the aircraft is suited for offshore conditions in the Gulf of Maine.

Scheduled maintenance is followed as required. The Evaluation Team will request that a State mechanic review the maintenance records for the aircraft as the Contract is drafted.

The Evaluation Team notes that the candidates for PIC meet the pilot requirements listed, and will request clarification from the bidder on the following listed credentials: Actual IFR Hours vs. Simulated IFR Hours, definitions for Low-Level vs Offshore hours, and SIC hours conducted as marine mammal surveys.

Insurance Requirements are met, in accordance with what was requested. Risk Assessment will evaluate the insurance documents provided to ensure that the State is listed as coinsured and meets State requirements as the Contract is drafted.
