

MAINE BOARD OF DENTAL PRACTICE
Application Checklist for Itinerant Dentist Sedation Permit

To qualify for a permit, an applicant must hold an active Maine dentist license and shall submit the following:

- Documentation of successful completion of an advanced education program accredited by the ADA Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA) that affords comprehensive and appropriate training necessary to administer and manage deep sedation or general anesthesia commensurate with the “ADA Sedation Guidelines” as outlined in Board Rule Chapter 14.
- Payment of total fees of \$850.00 (application fee \$100.00; permit fee \$750.00)
- Copy of current, valid life support certifications (BLS, ACLS, and PALS - required for pediatric sedation)
- Attest to complying with the requirement as outlined in Board Rule Chapter 14, Section IX(A)(4) to submit to the Board a signed, written agreement 14 days prior to providing services with an operating dentist:
