**PETITION TO INTERVENE BY THE  
CITY OF CALAIS**


Pursuant to Chapter 30 §5(A)(1) of the Department of Environmental Protection regulations, the City of Calais, Maine, hereby petitions to intervene in the above listed proceeding. A petition shall be granted if the petition demonstrates that it: (1) has a direct and substantial interest that may be affected by the proceeding; (2) has reasonably specific contentions regarding the subject matter of the hearing and the appropriate statutory criteria; and (3) is prepared and capable of participation in the hearing to support such contentions. 06-096 Ch. 30 §5(A)(1). The City of Calais hereby petitions to intervene in the proceeding and states the following:

1. The Calais LNG Project Company, LLC and the Calais Pipeline Project Company, LLC (“Calais LNG”) proposes to locate its Terminal, Pier and a portion of its sendout pipeline within the city limits of the City of Calais, Maine. The proposed project will therefore directly impact the municipality, creating a direct and substantial interest that may be affected by this proceeding.
  
2. The City of Calais has specific contentions relating to the Calais LNG permit applications that are subject to these proceeding, including but not limited to the following:

- i. That proposed project be been sited and designed in a manner that will not adversely affect the existing uses, scenic character, air quality, water quality, visual quality or other natural resources within the municipality; and
  - ii. That proposed project adequately provides for its needed utilities, including necessary water supply, electricity supply and solid waste disposal required for its project and will therefore not adversely impact existing or proposed utilities within the municipality or areas served by those services.
3. The City of Calais is prepared and capable of participation in the hearing to support its contentions, including participating in all pre-hearing conferences, providing detailed and accurate prefiled testimony and participating fully at any public hearing required by the Board.
4. Based on the foregoing, the City of Calais has satisfied the requirements for intervention and respectfully requests that it be granted Intervenor status in this proceeding.
