Air Emission License  
Amendment #1**

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

After review of the air emission license amendment application, staff investigation reports, and other documents in the applicant's file in the Bureau of Air Quality, pursuant to 38 Maine Revised Statutes (M.R.S.) § 344 and § 590, the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (Department) finds the following facts:

**I. REGISTRATION**

**A. Introduction**

True Textiles, Inc. (True Textiles) was issued Air Emission License A-367-71-N-R/M on 05/23/2017, for the operation of emission sources associated with its textile manufacturing facility.

True Textiles has requested a minor revision to their license in order to install a parts washer.

The equipment addressed in this license amendment is located at 9 Oak Street, Guilford, Maine.

**B. Emission Equipment**

The following equipment is addressed in this Air Emission License Amendment:

**C. Application Classification**

All rules, regulations, or statutes referenced in this air emission license refer to the amended version in effect as of the issued date of this license.

This amendment will increase licensed emissions by less than 4 ton/year for each single pollutant not including greenhouse gases (GHG) and less than 8 ton/year for all pollutants combined not including GHG. Therefore, this amendment is determined to be a minor revision and has been processed as such.

## II. BEST PRACTICAL TREATMENT (BPT)

### A. Introduction

In order to receive a license, the applicant must control emissions from each unit to a level considered by the Department to represent Best Practical Treatment (BPT), as defined in *Definitions Regulation*, 06-096 C.M.R. ch. 100. Separate control requirement categories exist for new and existing equipment.

BPT for new sources and modifications requires a demonstration that emissions are receiving Best Available Control Technology (BACT), as defined in *Definitions Regulation*, 06-096 C.M.R. ch. 100. BACT is a top-down approach to selecting air emission controls considering economic, environmental and energy impacts.

### B. Parts Washer

The requested parts washer will be installed in 2017 and has a design capacity of 30 gallons. The parts washer is subject to *Solvent Cleaners*, 06-096 C.M.R. ch. 130 and records shall be kept documenting compliance.

The inclusion of this parts washer in the license will subsequently cause it to be covered by Specific Condition (20) in license A-367-71-N-R/M.

### C. Annual Emissions

This Modification does not change True Textiles' licensed annual emissions.

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**ORDER**

Based on the above Findings and subject to conditions listed below, the Department concludes that the emissions from this source:

- will receive Best Practical Treatment,
- will not violate applicable emission standards, and
- will not violate applicable ambient air quality standards in conjunction with emissions from other sources.

The installation of this Parts Washer does not require any additional conditions to be added to the license. Therefore, the Department hereby grants Air Emission License Amendment A-367-71-O-M subject to the conditions found in Air Emission License A-367-71-N-R/M.

Severability. The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of this License Amendment or part thereof shall not affect the remainder of the provision or any other provisions. This License Amendment shall be construed and enforced in all respects as if such invalid or unenforceable provision or part thereof had been omitted.
