FINDINGS OF FACT

After review of the air emission license amendment application, staff investigation reports, and other documents in the applicant's file in the Bureau of Air Quality, pursuant to 38 Maine Revised Statutes (M.R.S.) § 344 and § 590, the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (Department) finds the following facts:

I. REGISTRATION

A. Introduction

Pike Industries, Inc. (Pike) was issued Air Emission License A-486-71-M-R/A on March 15, 2016, for the operation of emission sources associated with their portable asphalt drum mix plant based in Anson, Maine. The license was subsequently amended on December 17, 2017 (A-486-71-N-M).

Pike Industries recently sold their Anson site and has moved the portable asphalt drum mix plant and its associated equipment that was previously located at the Anson site to their site located in New Vineyard, Maine. Pike has requested a minor revision to their license in order to document their divesting of interest in the Anson site and their relocation of these assets to New Vineyard.

Pike's main office is located at 95 Warren Avenue in Westbrook, Maine.

B. Emission Equipment

No emission equipment is being modified or otherwise affected as a result of this minor revision.

C. Application Classification

All rules, regulations, or statutes referenced in this air emission license refer to the amended version in effect as of the issued date of this license.

This amendment will not increase emissions of any pollutant. Therefore, this amendment is determined to be a minor revision and has been processed as such.
