After reviewing the project file which includes the application with its supportive data, agency review comments, staff summary and other related materials on file with regard to the above noted project, under provisions of Title 38, M.R.S.A., Sec. 483 and 1304, the Department finds the following facts:

1. The applicant has submitted evidence concerning compliance with Condition #2 and 5 of the Order of the Board of Environmental Protection dated September 8, 1982. The nature of the evidence is:
  - A. Site plans, specifications and descriptions of work to be done; and a notification when the instillation of both the 24" pipe and the basal sand blanket was begun.
2. Condition #2 and 5 read as follows:
  2. Plans and specifications for the remaining Phase II work shall be submitted for DEP approval before its construction is begun.
  5. DEP will be notified when installation of both the 24" pipe and basal sand blanket is begun.

Based upon the above Findings, the Department concludes that STATLER INDUSTRIES has complied with Condition #2 and 5 of the Order for the Augusta Paper Mill Sludge Disposal Site dated September 8, 1982.
