STAFF ORDER

) FINDINGS OF FACT AND ORDER

After review of the application, related materials contained in the project file, and staff comments, pursuant to 06-096 CMR 1, Sec. (8)(D)(1), the Department finds the following facts:

1. The application requests the transfer of Board Order #08-017 from George B. Frederick to Porter W. Frederick.
2. Board Order #08-017 was issued to George B. Frederick on 9 October 1974, for approval of a 4.5 acre septage disposal site, located off Black Point road in Scarborough, Maine.
3. The applicant, Porter W. Frederick, has bought George B. Frederick's septic tank pumping business and has submitted the following in support of his request to assume the site permit:
 - a. George B. Frederick has agreed to transfer his site permit to the applicant.
 - b. The applicant has certified he is familiar with the project file on the septage disposal site, and will comply with the conditions of the original Board Order granting approval of the site, and that he is financially capable of maintaining and operating the disposal site in a manner that meets air, land and water pollution control standards.
 - c. The owner of the property on which the septage disposal site is located, Louis E. Larrabee has agreed to allow the continued use of his property for septage disposal by the applicant.
4. A site inspection by DEP staff on 8 June 1982 revealed that the disposal site is being operated in compliance with the site operating criteria adopted by the Board, except that warning signs must be erected and disposal has occurred within 300' of a wet, marshy area. The applicant has indicated a willingness to correct these deficiencies.

THEREFORE, the Department APPROVES the transfer of Board Order #08-017 from George B. Frederick to Porter W. Frederick, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The Standard Conditions of Approval, a copy attached.
2. The applicant shall submit an annual report on the amount of septage disposal of at the site to the Department, on or before the first of November of each year.
3. The applicant shall comply with all terms and conditions of Board Order #08-017, which originally approved the site for septage disposal.
