Hello Erle,

I just completed comments for Robin Reed of our office who will send them out. Basically I recommended the project proceed as planned with the understanding that burials could be present east of the road. Archaeological assessments of cemeteries, at the very least, should include some subsurface observation of soils in an attempt to determine if any burial shafts are present. The visual walkover helped to confirm that the area is not conducive for such due to low and rocky conditions. The metal detector survey was pretty useless given the questions that needed to be answered. Since no subsurface work was done, there is still the potential for burials to be present so the construction crew should be made aware of this. If internments are found, the town and our office should be notified to determine a course of action. Robin should get a letter out Monday or Tues. Have a great weekend.
